

## Culture and Sport – Flags in Oneplace

Oneplace has extensive search facilities, but no one search finds all the important references as culture's place in area assessment is largely determined by how individual authorities have referred to it and used it in their SCS or LAA.

The following flags in Oneplace all make some reference to culture or cultural activities. They were identified searching flags with the following key words: culture, active / activities, sport, visitor, art (s), library / libraries, tourism, museum.

Only flags with significant culture content are highlighted and there are others where culture or sport are briefly referenced.

City of London	Culture for everyone	Throughout
Kingston upon Thames	Partnership working to make the town centre safe, attractive and vibrant	Throughout
Southwark	Involvement of local people and the community and voluntary sector in enhancing community cohesion	General references to cultural type activities in bringing the community together to strengthen cohesion
Sutton	Environmentally sustainability	Culture is one of the ten areas covered by the plan to reduce their carbon footprint
Westminster	Community engagement	Culture links to strong and engaged communities and participation in volunteering
Camden	Improving quality of life for older people	Helping older people to stay healthy and improve their fitness / Providing cultural and social activities for older people / Older people and satisfaction with parks
Lewisham	Community engagement and empowerment of local people	Helping young people to get involved in positive activities, e.g. sport and arts
Northamptonshire	Recovery and regeneration in North Northants (Corby)	Corby Town centre – design quality and culture facilities
Nottinghamshire	Access to services for older people	Making sure older people have access to hobbies and activities
Somerset	Promoting independence and better health for older people	Active living centres – provide exercise classes and a range of social networks and activities
Wakefield	Bringing communities together – developing local nature reserves	Development of nature reserves has increased voluntary and community participation / Increased opportunities for physical activity
Westminster	Older people	References to improved culture opportunities (libraries, social events, physical activity) for older people throughout

## Red flags

Area	Flag title	Culture reference
Barking and Dagenham	Health outcomes and partnership working	Physical activity links to health
Blackburn with Darwen	Effective action to prevent early deaths from cancer and circulatory disease	Physical activity links to health
Doncaster	Poor prospects for Doncaster's children and young people	Physical activity links to health (particularly obesity) in children and young people
Leicester	Improving life expectancy and reducing health inequalities	Physical activity links to health – also linked to sports facilities
Warrington	Reducing health inequalities	Physical activity links to health
Stockport	Improving quality of life in poorer neighbourhoods	Reference to the role of sport and leisure in helping people
Trafford	Working with other organisations	Reference to the cultural partnership within the overall context of managing performance
Warwickshire	Ensuring all organisations improve the success and wellbeing of the people of Warwickshire.	Emphasis on all public services working better together
Worcestershire	Difference in the quality of life in Redditch	This is about inequality across the county; culture and sport are not mentioned specifically, but should contribute to improvement.

## Other red flags

Barnsley has a red flag for improving health for all; sport is not mentioned specifically, but issues for the community include heart disease and being overweight.

Knowsley has a red flag for community cohesion, there is no specific reference to culture, but planned actions include increasing the sense of belonging.
