What do we mean by volunteering?

- ➤ Volunteering is part of a professionally managed library service which:
- > Adds capacity to help deliver your service
- ➤ Brings diverse skills and experience/specialist support to specific projects
- > Offers enthusiasm and a fresh perspective
- Builds stronger community links
- Develops sustainability through a network of supporters



Which activities can volunteers support?

- ➤ Reading Groups for children, young people & adults
- ➤ Summer Reading Challenge
- ➤ Six Book Challenge
- ➤ Author Events/Library Events
- > Homework Clubs
- >IT support
- > Day to day delivery of the service





Planning a reading group activity

- ➤ Volunteers can support library staff to plan a reading group programme
- ➤ Produce any materials needed in advance of the group meeting
- > Help to publicise the group
- ➤ Ensure that books are ordered and available at the required time
- > Set up the space, manage the refreshments

- Story Lab Reporters
 - Blogging and recording
- Team Leaders
 - Planning and supporting



Planning to support the Challenges

Six Book Challenge

- ➤ Supporting library staff running library tours/events for learners
- ➤ Supporting library staff when learners are returning/borrowing books
- ➤ Supporting library staff on visits to classes
- > Supporting staff for celebration events



Planning an Author Event

- ➤ Volunteers can support the choice of author by talking to reading groups
- ➤ Using their community links
- ➤ Supporting library staff to promote and publicise the event
- Offering practical support...ticketing/setting up/refreshments
- ➤ Selling books
