### **Volunteer's Description of Tasks**

#### 3. What would be required of volunteers?

- (i) Volunteers need to be willing to discuss libraries and literacy volunteers will be provided with copies of the staff newsletter, the Events Calendar and other promotional material so that they will have up-to-date information about the service.
- (ii) All volunteers are required to undergo a Criminal Record Bureau check, (which the Council would arrange), and to provide references.
- (iii) It may be necessary to attend a short induction course, task-related training and regular feedback sessions.
- (iv) Ambassadors will be provided with a badge which they will be encouraged to wear the badge is eye-catching and designed to initiate enquiries and discussion.
