Appendix 2: Detailed maps of GB urban areas

This document contains maps of fixed broadband speed in Great Britain at regional level. It forms a supplement to the main briefing paper and data downloads, which can be found here. It is based on data from Ofcom's Connected Nations 2015 release.

The maps here show the percentage of connections which are receiving speeds lower than 10 Mbits/second. Government policy is to provide speeds of 10 Mbits/sec to all connections by 2020. The map shows this data for lower level super output areas, which are small areas with a population of around 1,500.

Other measures are available. On request, library staff can provide MPs and their staff with maps of their local area for the following measures:

- Average fixed broadband speed
- Availability of superfast and ultrafast lines
- Percentage of connections receiving speeds less than 2 Mbits/sec
- Percentage of connections receiving superfast speeds (30 Mbits/sec or higher)
