

WESTMINSTER BUSINESSES OFFER MODEL SOLUTIONS...

Every year, Westminster City Council holds a week of activities aligned with British Science Week to engage young people in STEM careers. The most recent activity week took place for 10 days in March 2018, and Westminster worked with the Victoria Business Improvement District and Westminster-based businesses to devise the programme.

One example of an opportunity offered to Westminster students was to visit David Miller Architects and find out about the use of 3D modelling in their architectural practice. The offer was for students to be given a brief lesson in using relevant software and then, in small groups, to design the interior office space of a Westminster based project that the Architectural Practice is currently working on. Other examples included a workshop in schools offered by Transport for London, using tangible travel scenarios to bring the Maths, Computing and Geography curriculum to life, and a careers day with leading STEM businesses.
