The Acting Chief Executive welcomed Members and introduced the three Co-Presidents, Lord Harris of Haringey, Lord Tope of Sutton and The Rt Hon. The Lord Barwell.

Lord Harris then chaired the meeting for the next three items on the agenda.

1. Declarations of interest

There were no declarations of interest.

2. Apologies for absence and notification of deputies

Apologies were as listed above.

3. Election of Chair

Lord Harris called for nominations for the position of Chair of London Councils and Cllr Georgia Gould (Camden, Labour) was nominated by Cllr Teresa O'Neill OBE (Bexley, Conservative) and seconded by Cllr Ruth Dombey OBE (Sutton, Lib Dem). There were no other nominations.

Cllr Georgia Gould was elected Chair of London Councils and took over chairing the meeting.

The Chair (Cllr Georgia Gould) thanked members and welcomed the new Leaders attending the Committee for the first time, namely: Cllr Peter Mason (Ealing); Cllr Peray Ahmet (Haringey); Cllr Kaya Comer-Schwartz (Islington); and Cllr Claire Holland (Lambeth). She also expressed her condolences concerning the recent death of Cllr Chris Robbins CBE, former Leader of the London Borough of Waltham Forest. She asked members to observe a minute's silence in his memory.

4. Election of Deputy Chair and up to Three Vice Chairs

The Chair then invited nominations for the Deputy Chair and up to three Vice-chairs. Cllr O'Neill OBE nominated Cllr Darren Rodwell (Barking and Dagenham, Labour) as Deputy Chair and that nomination was seconded by Cllr Ruth Dombey OBE (Sutton, Lib Dem).

Cllr Rodwell was elected as Deputy Chair of London Councils.

5. Minutes of the meeting of the AGM Leaders' Committee on 13 October 2020

Leaders' Committee agreed to note the minutes of the meeting of the AGM of Leaders' Committee on 13 October 2020 already agreed by Leaders' Committee on 8 December 2020.

6. Appointment of London Councils Co-Presidents for 2021/22

The Chair nominated and Cllr Elizabeth Campbell (Kensington & Chelsea, Conservative) seconded the following: The Lord Harris of Haringey (Labour Peer), The Lord Tope CBE (Liberal Democrat Peer) and The Rt Hon. The Lord Barwell (Conservative Peer). All were appointed as Co-Presidents of London Councils, and invited to address members.

Lord Harris was delighted to continue as Co-President and informed members that it was important to make the case for London, to emphasise both its inequalities and common purpose, and to link with other centres of local government throughout the country.

The Rt Hon The Lord Barwell recognised three challenges facing London; the importance of the role of the capital in the levelling up debate; the decarbonisation of the economy; and devolution considerations. He also recognised the key role of boroughs in post pandemic recovery and recorded his wish to assist where possible.

Lord Tope congratulated boroughs for the leadership strength they had demonstrated over the past year and felt that this contribution had not been fully recognised.
