2	<ul> <li>ALB Update and Items to Feedback (Alex Wylde)</li> <li>AW advised that work is currently being done to understand if enough adopters are being recruited to meet demand. Details to be brought to the next meeting.</li> <li>Andrew Christie will be observing each regional adoption board meeting and is planning to come to the London Adoption Board meeting in December.</li> <li>AW to circulate the minutes of ALB meetings to LAB members.</li> </ul>	LAB181 AW to circulate ALB meeting minutes
3	<ul> <li>Regional Analysis of ALB Data (Alex Wylde)</li> <li>AW presented 'London Adoption Board data report' and asked for feedback about what is useful and what could be improved. The following suggestions arose:</li> <li>Possibly focus on under 5s only.</li> <li>More context is needed - consider including data on the number (and age) of children looked after, the number of care proceedings, number of rescinds, the number of SGOs, the nature of children leaving care, children moving out of London mid- or post-proceedings and the number of children subject to repeat proceedings.</li> <li>An indication of the number of children adopted per 1000 population would give a comparator.</li> <li>Timeliness would need to be compared to another city with the complexity of London children to give a true picture.</li> <li>Adopter recruitment needs further consideration as it appears to be an emerging problem.</li> <li>HE pointed out that this needs to be looked at in conjunction with the data that Richard Morris (CAFCASS) will be providing on the outcomes of proceedings, and she will liaise with AW re next stage.</li> </ul>	LAB182 HE and AW to discuss next steps for regional data analysis
4	Regionalisation Update (service design) (Jeanne Kaniuk, Mark Keeley, Kara Renno, Peter Sandiford)  KR presented 'London Regional Adoption Agency – Service Design Workstream' which looked at the LRAA functions in each practice area. KR confirmed that the hub and spoke model has been confirmed as the delivery model, but that the details haven't yet been finalised (ie how many spokes), and it was agreed that this will have to be looked at broadly to	

	ensure it is not restrictive.
